



Let us not DEPART from the living God


- Be aware of God's wrath if we depart from Him
 - Hebrews 3:8-14
- The only way to return to God is to repent
 - Acts 26:20; 2 Timothy 2:19



Let us not DEPART from the living God

- Sin has <u>ALWAYS</u> been that which separates man from God
 - Isaiah 59:2; 1 John 3:4

"But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear." Isaiah 59:2



The Danger of Departing

- Be gathered out
 - John 3:5
 - Matthew 13:41-42
- Will forget about God
 - Jeremiah 2:32
 - Psalms 9:17
- Better to not have known
 - 2 Peter 2:20-22



The Danger of Departing

- Will depart from the faith
 - 1 Timothy 4:1-2
- Will fall from grace
 - Galatians 5:4
 - Romans 11:22
 - 1 Corinthians 10:11-13
- God is not partial
 - Ezekiel 18:21-25



Reasons for Departing from God

Influence of religious leaders

- Ephesians 4:14
- Galatians 1:6-12
- Isaiah 9:16
- Overabundance of self-confidence
 - Proverbs 28:26
 - Luke 22:31-34



Reasons for Departing from God

- Lack of training
 - Proverbs 22:6
 - Ephesians 6:4
- The love of the world
 - 1 John 2:12-17
 - 2 Timothy 4:10



The Results of Departing from God

- Kept Israel out of Canaan
 - Hebrews 3:10-11
- Will keep us out of heaven
 - Hebrews 4:1,11
 - Luke 13:27-28
