 - To bring people to faith in Christ
 - 1 Corinthians 2:4-5
 - To edify the Church
 - 1 Corinthians 14:12, 26

1 Corinthians 13:8-13


"When that which is perfect has come..." (Verses 9-10)

"For we know in part and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away."

"perfect" (teleios)
that which grows to completeness or wholeness

Paul's Analogy of Child to man (Verse 11)

"When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things."

Now I know in part, but then I shall know just as I also am known."

What will abide? (Verse 13)

"And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the **greatest of these is love**."

FAITH – will one day be realized

HOPE – will one day be realized

LOVE – will abide forever!
