Introduction

John 8:32-33 And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

2 Thessalonians 2:9-12 The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, and with all **unrighteous deception** among those who perish, **because they did not receive the love of the truth**, that they might be saved. And for this reason God will send them **strong delusion**, that **they should believe the lie**, that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth **but had pleasure in unrighteousness**.

- 1. Before we can be made free, we must first know the truth.
 - A. The only way to know the truth is to develop a genuine love of the truth.
 - B. We develop faith and a love of the truth from hearing the truth. (Romans 10:17).
- 2. Three things are necessary to obedience to God.
 - A. Study
 - B. Learn the truth
 - C. Put it into practice
 - 1) All three of these points can give us difficulty if we let it. The third point is perhaps the most difficult for most people to include myself when I first learned of the differences in churches of Christ.

 - A. Relate the story of learning the difference in churches of Christ.

Lessons Learned

- 1. What we have been taught may not necessarily be right.
 - A. We must change when we know that we are wrong.
 - 1) We must, even at a tender age, do as the Bereans:

Acts 17:11.... receive the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so.

There's Only One Difference

- 1. When all was said and done I soon realized that there is only one difference between the institutional brethren and the conservative brethren.
 - A. Conservative brethren could provide book, chapter, and verse in context for all that is done in the name of the Lord, while the institutional brethren could not.
- 2. I have talked with many Christians in the institutional church that had no clue that things being done in the church where they were attending were unscriptural.
 - A. Like me, they had never really studied in such a way as to really wanting to know the truth.
- 3. Sadly, there are even those among our number that have not heard much teaching concerning the issues so as to understand the differences and to study these things for themselves.
 - A. So as to be convicted that what we are doing is right in God's sight!

Understanding Why I Left

- 1. Respect For Bible Authority 2 Peter 1:20-21
- 2. Knowing what "expediency" is
 - A. For a thing to be expedient it must be lawful to begin with.
- 3. Fellowship Halls and Entertainment is not a work of the church.
- 4. The Benevolent work of the church is restricted to the saints.
- 5. Knowing there is a scriptural plan for church cooperation.

Conclusion

1. We must consider the cost of being a disciple of Jesus.

Luke 9:23 Then He said to them all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.

- 2. That means that we must:
 - A. Study 2 Timothy 2:15
 - B. Learn the truth John 8:32
 - C. Practice the truth Matthew 7:21
- 3. I had to leave the unscriptural institutional church and the close relationship with my parents and sisters that I once had in order to be pleasing to God. Matthew 10:34-39
 - A. Are you prepared to leave that which is unscriptural and sinful for the cause of Christ?
 - 1) What you choose to do will determine your eternity!
